**Academic Advising Notes:**

<sup>S</sup> Effective Fall 2012, all incoming Schreyer Honors College freshmen at University Park will take [ENGL/CAS 137H](#) in the fall semester and [ENGL/CAS 138T](#) in the spring semester. These courses carry GWS designation and replace both ENGL 030 and CAS 100. Each course is 3 credits. At the discretion of the college, ENGL/CAS 138T satisfies the first-year seminar requirement.

**Program Notes:** Continuous enrollment in RPTM 498G (Player Development/Tournament Golf) is required each semester on campus until the PGA of America's Playing Ability Test (PAT) is passed..
