

**Recommended Academic Plan for Recreation, Park and Tourism Management/Outdoor Recreation-Adventure Based Emphasis (RPTM/OUTRC assumes four full-time semesters at campuses other than University Park)
Effective Fall 2004**

- W is the code used to designate courses that satisfy University Writing Across the Curriculum requirement.

Scheduling patterns for courses not taught each semester: RPTM 230, 320, 325, 440 fall only; RPTM 330 summer only; RPTM 334, 430, 470, 480, spring only.

Program Notes:

1. Students take 6 credits of: ERM, FOR, WFS, GEOSC, GEOG or BI SC 003 plus required 9 credits GN classes before coming to UP.
2. STAT 100 or 200 or ED PSY 101 needed to meet one of General Quantification requirements for all options.
3. Students who have not completed First-Year Seminar may substitute RPTM 230.
